• Safety Report... Rich recommends that we review the following rules. No flying over the pit area as well as the satellite station and farm barns, any high-speed passes must be done from the middle of runway and out away from the boxes. The eagle

observation area is open during the winter months so we should avoid flying over the

far western area of our flight zone.

FIELD MAINTENANCE:

Overall, the field is in good shape. If we get snow, try not to walk on the field, it makes

it difficult for planes using skies or floats

allow space for more charging were discussed.
