MEMBERSHIP

 Membership Report... Ken reported we have 71 paid members that includes 4 junior members.

TREASURER'S REPORT:

• Financial Report.... Ken reported the club is in good financial shape. We have also had several donations.

SOUND AND SAFETY: Rich Margules

- Safety Report... Rich has advised members to not arm electric planes unless they are on the flite line.
- AED Update... Rich has been researching AEDs. He suggested we have a member that
 takes responsibility for maintenance and training. Nino has volunteered. More
 research needs to be done regarding the feasibility of installation at our field due to
 temperature extremes. Rich will continue the investigation.
- Refresher Flight Training ... It has been suggested that we have a designated training
 night to be held on a weekday evening that would have instructors available to help
 members improve their flying skills. Bill suggested a lite BBQ may get things started.
 Date to be determined.
- Bill informed members that the first aid kit presently in the mower shed will be moved to the warming hut, so it is more available.

FIELD MAINTENANCE:

- Overall, the field is in good shape. As we get the spring rain, be careful of the soft soil in the parking lot, particularly on the far side.
- Spring Field Day will be in mid or late April weather dependent...More to come in the near future.

OLD BUSINESS:

- A plan has been confirmed to donate our SWAP meet proceeds to a local charity. This
 year to Southbury Ambulance/Fire Dept.
- 8 club members have volunteered to help at our public "Come learn about RC planes &
 flying" part of the SWAP meet. Bill spoke with the AMA, and they are happy to
 participate and support with funds. Bill asked Ron to investigate having this type of

stand-alone event in Southbury, so it doesn't interfere with the Swap meet. We'll have

a separate discussion with the volunteers to divide up the adventure.

NEW BUSINESS:

Bill provided an update on Wilton flying site FAA inspection. Someone made a

complaint to the FAA. The FAA inspector came to the site in Wilton which is not FRIA

approved. Some members of the Wilton club did not have required electronic Id

modules or paperwork.

• Chris Vargo delivered a very detailed power point presentation on what is required by

law to comply with AMA & FAA Rules. FLYRC field has FRIA approval, so no ID module

is required. All planes must have the FAA number on the outside of the plane. They

must have the name of the owner, AMA number on the plane somewhere that is easily

accessible. It was advised to have a label with all the information on the outside of the

plane. A label with name, telephone number, FAA#, and AMA# is available from many

sources or could easily be printed on a standard mailing label. All FLYRC members must

comply when flying at the FLYRC field. If you fly at a non-FRIA approved site, you must

have an electronic ID module installed in your plane as well as the label discussed

above. An email with this information will be sent to FLYRC club members.
